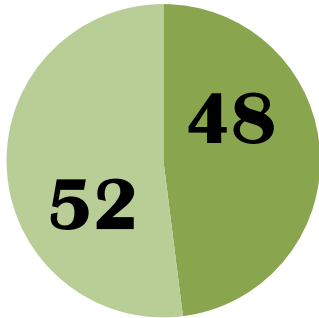


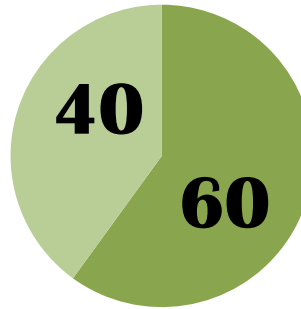
# OUTCOME OF CUBAN AMERICAN VOTERS IN THE 2012 PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

A very widely cited report by Bendixen & Amandi International, that gives a very good break down of Florida Votes as well as the Cuban-American vote in the 2012 elections.

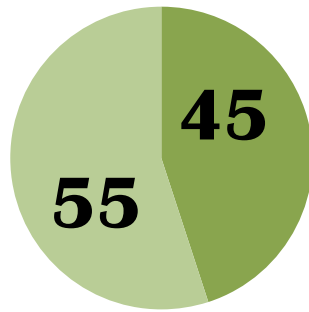

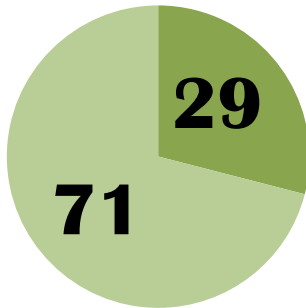

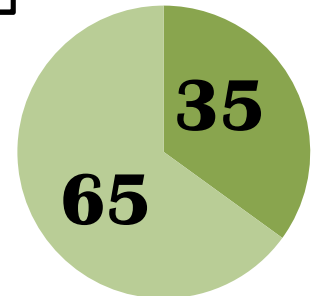

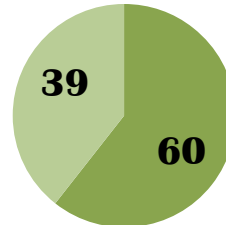
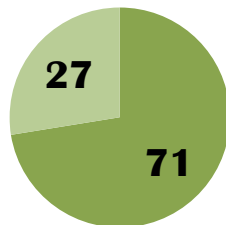

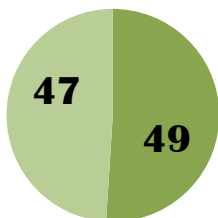


Latino Voters in the 2012 Election – Pew Research Hispanic Center

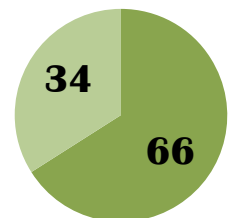
**Latinos voted for President Barack Obama over Republican Mitt Romney by 71% to 27%**



**Obama carried Florida's Hispanic vote 60% to 39%**



**[In Florida] Among Cuban voters, the vote was split—49% supported Obama while 47% supported Romney. Among the state's non-Cuban voters, Obama won 66% versus 34% for Romney.**
